

Prevention Measures

Church Building Use is booked through our communications coordinator, Meghan Kort, by emailing community@terracecrc.org

These measures are intended to keep our gatherings at low risk for transmission of spreadable illness.

- Please stay home if you are sick or not feeling well
- Clean hands frequently – hand sanitizer will be made available at entrances, at food service, and soap at all sinks for handwashing.
- Masks are not required in the building – some people based on level of risk or comfort, or in areas where physical distancing is not possible may choose to wear a mask
- Continue to give others space – in the sanctuary, fellowship hall and in meeting spaces. During transition to lesser restrictions, we will continue to have a few pews at the back of the sanctuary with yellow tape to allow room for those who are more comfortable with defined spacing
- Regular cleaning/disinfecting – facility cleaning provided weekly by our custodian

1. Children and Youth Activities

- a. Under 12 – resume as normal
- b. Over 12 – same prevention measures as adults (above)

2. Singing/Instruments

- a. No limitations – to lower risk of transmission we recommend continued spacing when leading worship and cleaning of mics, etc. after use, with the wipes provided.

3. Serving Food/Beverages

- a. Food safety practices for all food preparation
- b. Hand hygiene for preparing/serving food and provide hand sanitizer where food/beverage is self served
- c. Wash dishes as per posted protocol and wipe down counters/surfaces with approved disinfectant
